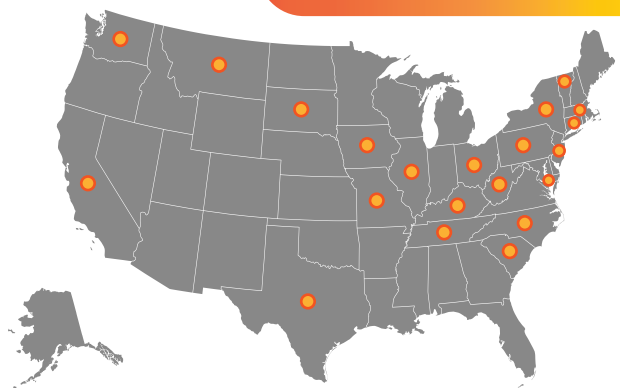
Gold Star Cities (GSC)

Tools for Local Change

Not In Our Town provides rapid response tools for on-the-ground action. The NIOT model helps cities build collaboration between elected and civic leaders, diverse community activists, faith leaders, educators, students, local business, and media to create a powerful force of change makers ready to prevent hate and make their towns safe for everyone.
