Killing of Police Officers in Law Vegas: Latest Warning on Violent Extremism

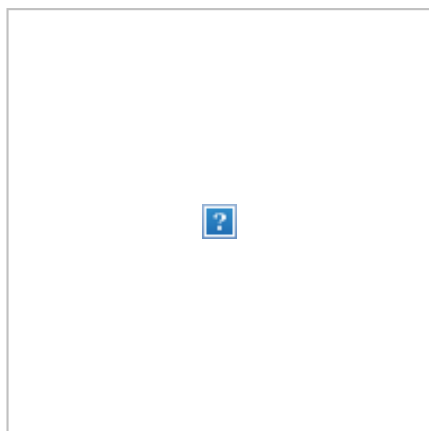


The Las Vegas shooting that left two officers and one bystander dead is the latest in a string of attacks. From 2009 through 2013, the Anti-Defamation League has tracked 43 separate violent incidents between domestic extremists and law enforcement in the United States.
