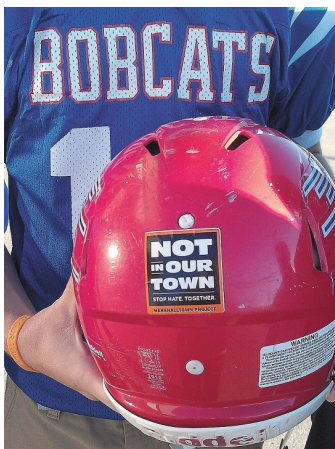


Son of Hate Crime Victim Asks Senators to Stand with Sikhs
